On Monday, 5-3-93, 3:55PM, 25th District Police responded to a R/C "SHOOTING & HOSPITAL CASE, 2828 N. HUTCHINSON St". Upon their arrival they learned the victim had been taken to Episcopal Hospital by a private auto & was pronounced dead at Episcopal from multiple GSW's to the head and body.					
The investigation revealed that the scene was in front of 2828 N. Hutchinson St., & the victim was shot by a Gregory SCOTT 14/B/M, residence, 2828 N. Hutchinson, during the course of an argument.					
On 5-4-93 Sgt MURRAY # 8581, contacted ADA Arlene FISK and advised her on all aspects of the investigation and ADA Fisk approved charges of Murder, PIC and PUFA for Defendant Gregory SCOTT-TONEY.

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next to GREG's house. When we had got there there was an argument going on between GREG & HECTOR. They was saying stuff back and forth. I think the arguement started when some piper lady walked down the street and HECTOR had said to GREG, "there goes your Moma". That's what I heard it started over. When I had got there they wqas already arguing. It got to where GREG wanted to fight with HECTOR but HECTOR was telling GREG that he was just a boy and he didn't fight boys and then GREG kept at it and finally HECOTER told GREG that he was putting him on his list and GREG was saying fine, put me on your list and stuff like that and then finally HECOTER just told GREG that he was gonna bust him and GREG said back to him something like yeah, go ahead and try and bust on me. Then all of a sudden GREG ran into his house and he came back out inless than a minute and he ahd this gun and he just shot HECTOR. I heard at least 4 shots maybe 5 shots and everybody was like stunned by what had happeneed because they was friends. Then I heard GREG's father shouting his name a and then GREG just started running down the street and across Somerset and he went up one of the little streets and me and WHAM ran after him but we couldn't find him.

Q. Do you know GREG's full name and address?

A. I just know him as GREG and his house is where the shooting happened, right out front.

Q. How long have you known GREG?

A. For about 5 or 6 years. He's lived in that house all that time. He lives with his father there.

Q. How long did you know HECTOR?

A. For about 4 years, we went to school together.

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Q. Why were you in the area of 9th & Somerset today?

A. My father, BENIGNO SERRANO, has the store at 9th & Somerset, NUNO's Grocery.

Q. Did you see the gun that GREG shot HECTOR with today?

A. I just saw the black handle when he put it in his pocket after he shot HECTOR.

Q. Did you see any kind of weapons on HECTOR's hands or on his person?

A. No.

Q. In your mind was there any reason for GREG to shoot and kill HECTOR?

A. No.

Q. Do you know where GREG went after the shooting?

A. No. I asked WHAM where he went and he told me that he hadn't been able to find him.

Q. Do you know WHAM's real name?

A. No, that's all I know him by. I don't even know where he lives. I just see him walking around.

Q. Who else was outside when this shooting occurred?

A. There was a tall guy that was out there and he was kind of keeping them apart, but I never seen him before. There some others out there but I don't know any of their names.

Q. Was GREG hurt in any way today by HECTOR that you know of?

A. No.

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Q. There was a bike parked in the street near where the blood was, do you know how it came to be there or who owns it?

A. It wasn't there when this happened. When I came back from trying to find GREG I saw it there but I don't know who put it there.

Q. The car that had its door open near the blood on the street, do you know why it was there?

A. I think that was the car HECTOR was working on before the arguement started.

Q. Did HECTOR say anything after he was shot by GREG?

A. Not that I know of.

Q. How old is GREG?

A. Like 15 or 14.

Q. Describe GREG?

A. He's Black, about 5'4", 150 - 160, dark complected, real short hair, tapered on the sides. He was wearing a dark blue hat like a baseball kind today.

Q. Do you know the color of the front door of GREG's house at Hutchinson & Auburn Sts?

A. It's brown.

Q. What did HECTOR do when GREG came out of his house with the gun?

A. HECTOR put his hands up like this. (Indicating his arms above his head with the palms facing forward, like a surrendering position.) HECTOR said, "if you're going to shoot me, shot me". Then GREG just shot him.

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Q. Is there anything else you can add that would help this investigation?

A. No.

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A. I had just come up to my Uncle, CARLOS BEAZ, house across the street from my house and I was waiting for him to come home because he was going to take me to my Grandma's house. I had only been out there for a couple of minutes when I heard some arguing, I looked towards Hutchinson St., and I saw that it was my cousin, HECTOR & his friend, GREG, they was arguing with each other. All I could hear was GREG saying, "I want it now, I want it now", and HECOTER was telling him, "you got to see who is responsible". Then GREG wanted to fight with HECTOR but HECTOR wouldn't fight him and then GREG ran into his house there, the one with the brown door that I showed you, (2828 N. Hutchinson St.), and in a couple of seconds he was coming out the front door again. His Pop tried to keep him from going back outside but he got past his Pop and then I seen that he had a gun and he just started to shoot HECTOR. I heard 6 shots and I saw HECTOR start to fall down on the street and that's when I started to run to HECTOR's house and tell his Mom. While I was running I could hear GREG's POP yelling, "you didn't have to shoot him, you're best friends". By the time I got HECTOR's Mom and went back to where he was, GREG was gone. I don't know where he went or where his father went.

Q. When you went back to where HECTOR was on the ground after he had been shot, did he ever say anything?

A. He couldn't, everytime he opened his mouth, blood just came out.

Q. Did you see any kind of weapon, a gun or a knife, in HECTOR'S hands today?

A. No, I never seen nothing in his hands.

Q. How long have you known this GREG who you saw shoot HECTOR?

A. For about 6 months.

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Q. Do you know who lives in GREG's house with him?

A. Just his Pop, his Mom lives somewhere else.

Q. Do you have any idea what HECTOR & GREG were arguing about today?

A. No, but I guess it was over money.

Q. Would you describe GREG & what he was wearing today?

A. He told me before that he was 14, he's about 5'3", medium weight, Black, dark complexion, and he was wearing blue jeans, a black shirt, a black hat, like a baseball kind with "Philly Blunt" on the front and a green flower. He has real short hair, almost bald like.

Q. How many gunshots did you hear during this incident?

A. 6

Q. Had you ever seen GREG with any kind of gun before today?

A. No.

Q. Could you describe the gun that GREG shot HECTOR with?

A. It was like a small gun, he was holding it with both his hands so I didn't get much of a look at it.

Q. Did you see anyone else outside that would have seen this shooting?

A. Just the friend of HECTOR's, I don't know his name, he didn't go to the hospital and he was gone when we came home from the hospital. He was older than Hector, about 23, today was the first time I seen him.

Q. Does HECTOR own or drive a car?

A. Yes, he has a 2 door light blue OLDSMOBILE, around a 1982. He had parked it in front of my house. His wife MARITZA wasn't with him.

Q. When HECTOR left, did he take his car?

A. Yes.

Q. How did you become aware that your brother had been shot?

A. I was in the house cooking and I heard around six (6) gunshots. They sounded real close, like it was right outside. My mother said "GO SEE. GO CHECK"! One on the right and one on the left. Another wound on the upper left back. I saw what appeared to be a graze wound on the back of the neck at the base of the skull. I saw two GSW's on the back of the head, one on the right and one in the center, about an inch apart. I observed another GSW on the pinkie finger on the left hand.

Q. When you observed the body, the victim was obviously dead?

A. Yes.

Q. What did you do next?

A. I went into a waiting room and spoke to Jose Lagere 15th fl. Res 910 W. Auburn.

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A... He stated the victim was his brother Hector Rodriguez who was shot. I asked him if he witnessed the shooting. He said he did not. He did say that a friend told him that Gregory Scott Toney had shot his brother.

Q. Did he identify the friend who gave him this information?

A. Not by name. He said he's a light skinned Hispanic male that he knows from the neighborhood. He did tell me that he was inside his residence at 910 W. AUBURN and that he heard the gunshots. He ran outside and found his brother laying on the ground at 2528 N. HUTCHINSON. I asked Jose if he brought his brother to the hospital. He said, "No, Angel did." 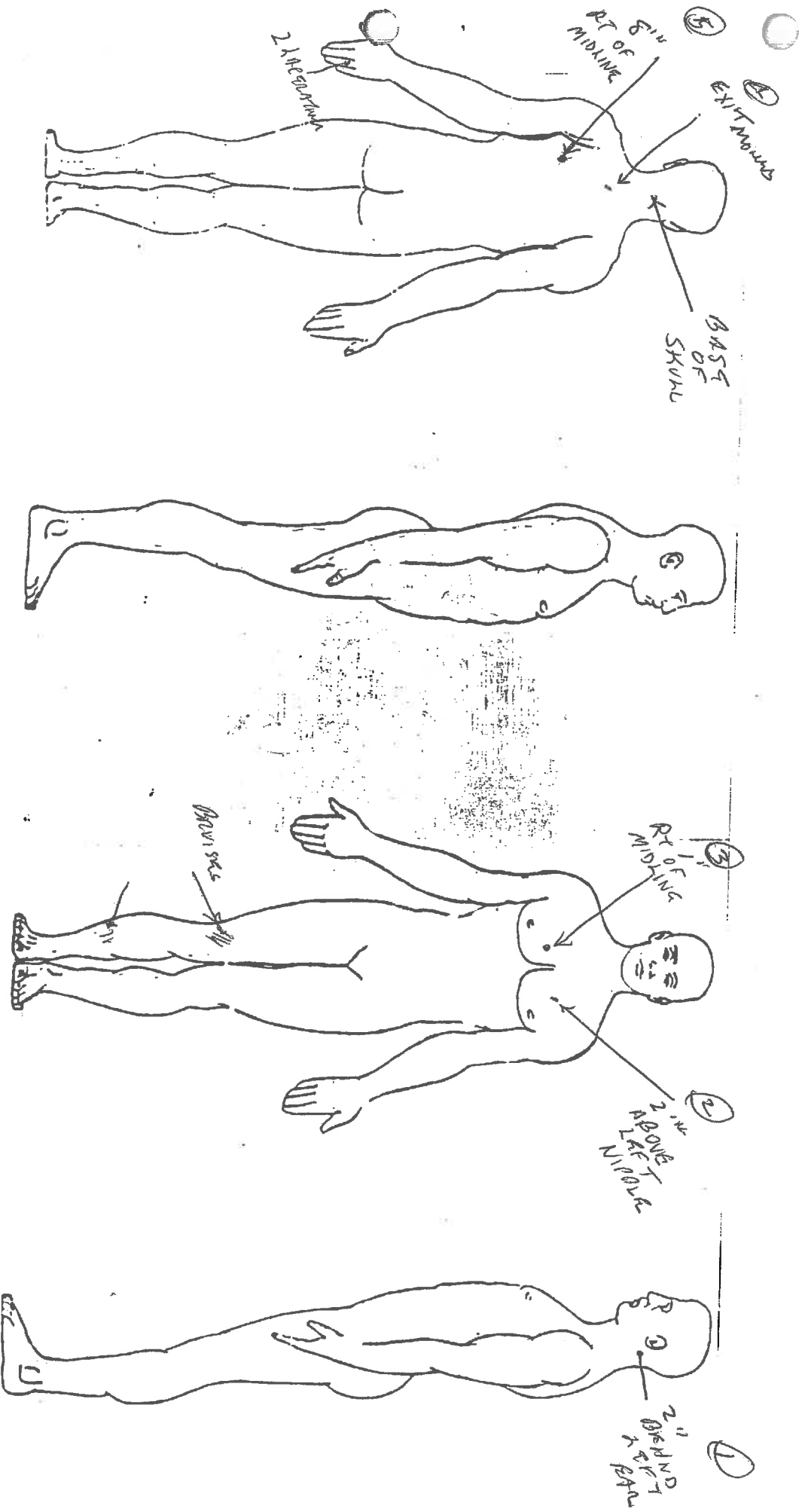
